Course Description

This course is designed to meet the needs of workers in the fenestration industry who need to ensure compliance with Australian Standard AS 1288. The course covers the unit of competency *LMFGG3002C Assess glass and glazing requirements* which is from the Certificate III in Glass and Glazing.

Compliance with standards presents a significant challenge to the industry. It is vital that everybody working in the window industry is conversant with standards; understand how they should be implemented and their own role in ensuring compliance.

To facilitate this across all levels of industry employees AWA has designed this course to provide the necessary knowledge and skills with regard to AS1288 (Glass in buildings—Selection and installation). The course will be conducted by industry experts offering both training and technical support. The course will incorporate real life scenarios and worked examples covering residential and commercial classes of buildings.

On completion of the course participants will understand the structure of the Standard and Supplement and be able to determine the correct glass type and thickness

to withstand wind and other design loads and be able to identify situations that require the use of safety glass. This one day course will also include explanations of the relationship of AS1288 with the window standard AS2047, the Building Code of Australia (BCA) and why compliance with Standards is essential.

Participants will be required to undertake a post-course assessment by completing a workbook that must be returned within one month of the date of the course. After assessment of the workbook successful participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment.

Required to bring:

A copy of Australian Standard AS1288-2006 Glass in buildings—selection and installation must be bought to the course and is also required for post-course assessment completion.

A copy can be purchased from the AWA for \$120 inc GST or online from SAI Global. Order forms are on the AFTI website or can be sent on request.

Eligibility

There are no prerequisites or eligibility requirements for this unit of competency.

Target Audience

The target audience for this training is anyone working in the fenestration industry (both new and existing workers), associated industries involved in the sale, design, or specification of windows, doors, balustrades or other glass items specified in the Australian Standard AS1288.

The training will enable participants to know the requirements of Australian Standards and the BCA and to have skills that enable them to implement those requirements including calculation of glass requirements for windload, regional zones, terrain and human impact considerations.

Learner Handbook

The Learner Handbook contains vital information on cancellations, refunds, policies and procedures and **must** be read prior to enrolment. A copy is available on the AFTI website www.afti.edu.au or a copy can be posted on request.

Assessment

Participants will be provided with an Assessment workbook which must be completed and returned within one month of the completion of the course. The assessment workbook contains assessment questions and requires the completion of two schedules based on information provided. In addition to the workbook a report from the participant's manager and samples of actual work undertaken will be required.

Learners will be given an additional opportunity to complete the assessment competently if not successful at the first attempt.

Upon successful completion of all of the assessment requirements learners will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for *LMFGG3002A Assess glass and glazing requirements*.
